The Undersigned hereby acknowledges that if any plumbing fixtures are connected to the Municipal Sanitary Sewer System below the grade of the existing manhole rim elevation without the installation of an approved backwater valve, it is done so at the sole responsibility of the undersigned and the Manchester Township Board of Supervisors or Municipal Authority will not be held liable for any damages resulting from said connection(s).

5. The applicant must submit a certification that materials used meet the Township's Construction and Materials Specifications. A certified compaction test result from the soil testing laboratory shall be submitted once the work is complete, for those installations occurring within Township road right-of-way. A \$200 inspection fee will be deducted from the deposit for each inspection. It is the contractor/applicant's responsibility to email requests for inspections on each day of work. Failure to comply will result in an action being brought before the district justice under a summary offence, which is subject to a fine of \$1,000, plus costs, per day the violation exists. Failure to pay said fines could result in imprisonment not to exceed 90 days per day violation exists.

6. The applicant certifies that all information on this application is correct, and the work will be completed in accordance with the "approved" construction documents, The Construction and Materials Manual and any additional approved building code requirements adopted by the Municipality. **The road will be restored from curb to curb the entire length of the roadway.** The applicant assumes the responsibility of locating all property lines, setback lines, easements, rights-of-way, flood areas, etc. Issuance of a permit and approval of construction documents shall not be construed as authority to violate, cancel, or set aside any provisions of the codes or ordinances of the Municipality or any other governing body. The applicant certifies he/she understands all the applicable codes, ordinances, and regulations.
